



COVID Exposure and Return to Participation in CRPA Programs



Thank you to those who continue to engage in our programs with Cherokee Recreation and Parks! In a continuing effort for public health and safety within our community we want to remain transparent and proactive. It is important for us all to be a part of the solution to keep our community safe and healthy. We request that anyone with a positive test or direct contact with a person who has tested positive make the program coordinator aware immediately.

Any program participant who:

- Has a positive test result;
- is in direct contact with an individual that has a current positive test;
- has been included in a mandatory quarantine through their school or work; (this does not include siblings of the mandatory quarantined participant) or
- is exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 as listed by the CDC

Cannot participate in CRPA programs until they have completed their 14-day quarantine and have been symptom free for the last three days.

If a participant is not able to participate due to meeting the criteria above then you can reach out to the program coordinator to request a refund or credit. When you do so please provide the following documentation: copy of email from school for mandatory quarantine, Dr. note, or copy of results from Dept. of Public Health.
